

## **Activating and Downloading charts from X-Traversal to use in GPSNavX and/or MacENC**

In order to use the charts from X-Traversal, they must be purchased, activated and downloaded on the Mac you plan to use them on. Follow this same procedure for both first time use or updating charts.

### **BEFORE PROCEEDING: QUIT MacENC or GPSNavX**

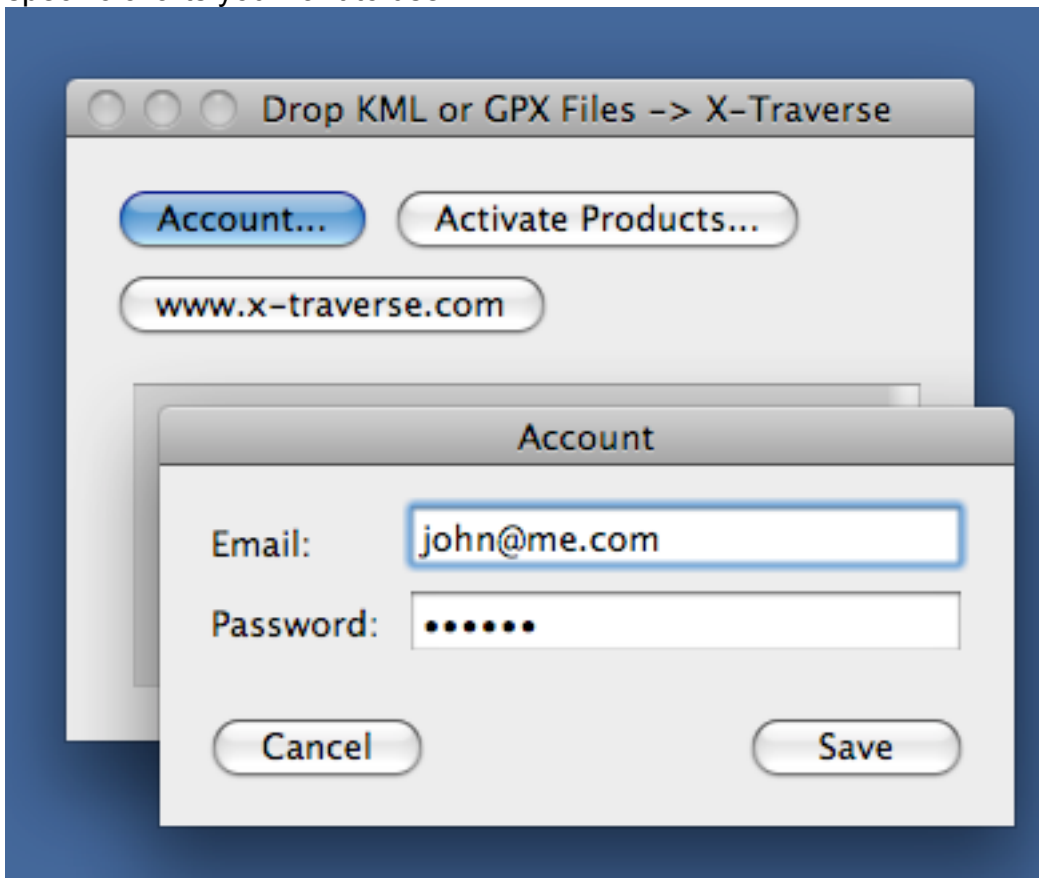
Download the X-Traversal Application from:

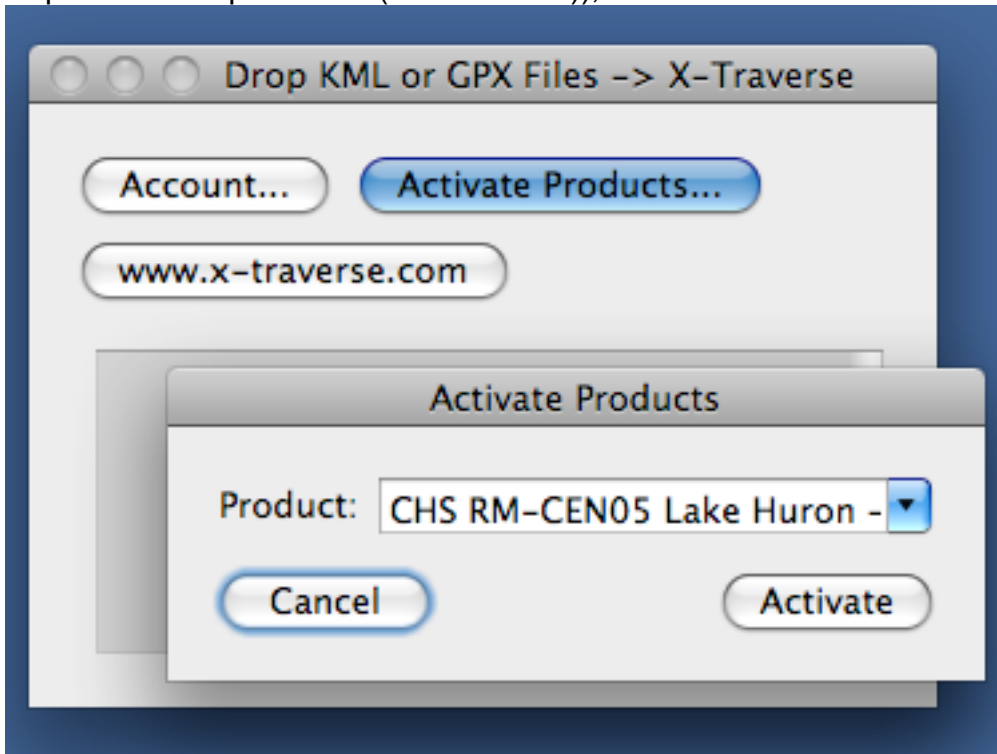
Launch the X-Traversal Application.

Proceed to the next page.

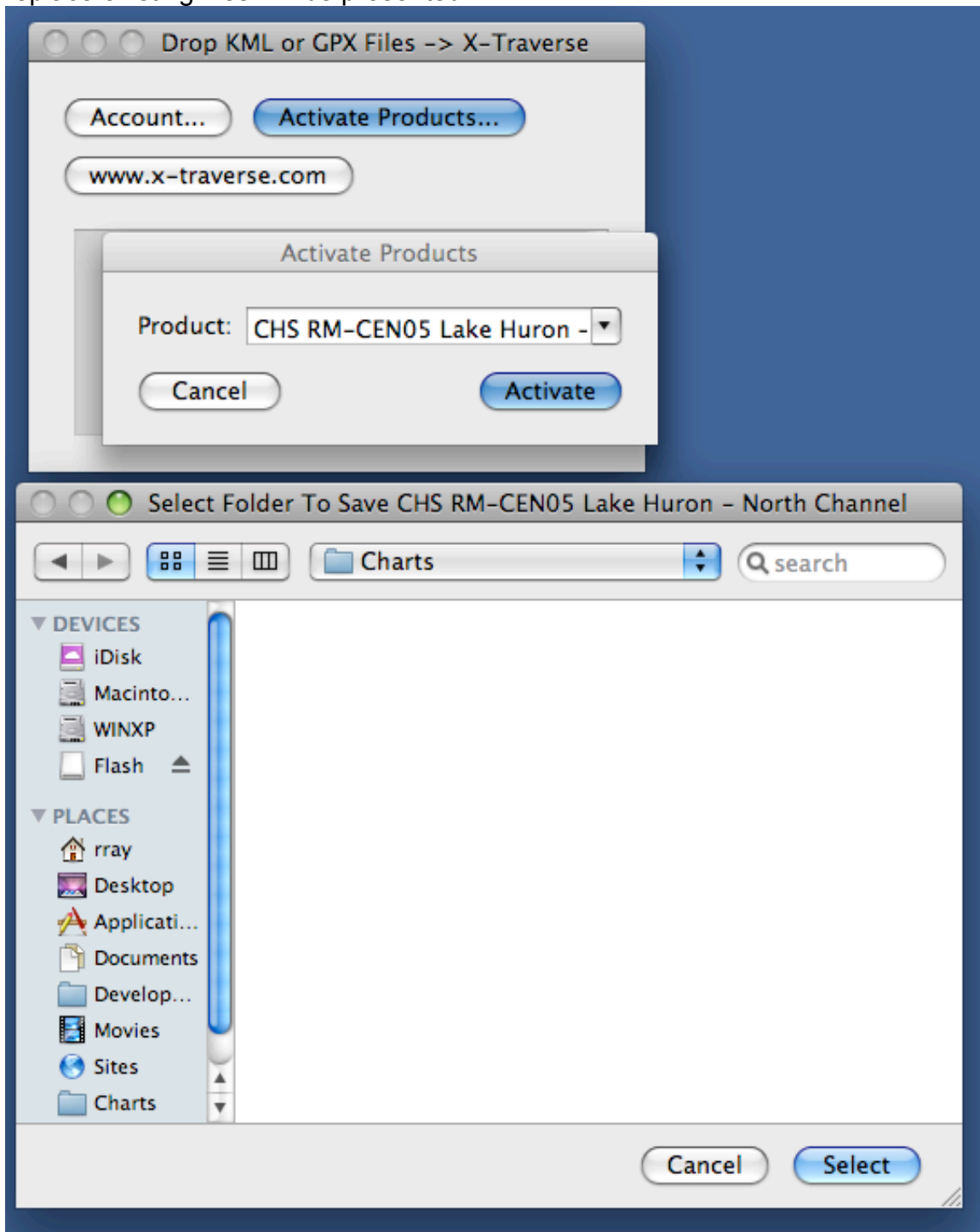
Press the **“Account”** button and enter your X-Traversal Account information. If you do not yet have an X-Traversal account please visit [www.x-traverse.com](http://www.x-traverse.com) and set up an account. If you have not done so you will also need to purchase the specific charts you want to use.



Select the “**Activate Products**” button and select the product you wish to activate and download (Note: only charts which you have purchased at [www.x-traverse.com](http://www.x-traverse.com) will list. Navionics charts are only compatible with MacENC and require an Intel processor (i.e. Macbook)), then Select the “**Activate**” button.



Select the top level FOLDER you wish to save the charts in. Typically a “Charts” folder is selected. The products will be saved to a subfolder of the product name. Select “**Select**” to confirm the FOLDER. If the subfolder exists, an option to replace existing files will be presented.



The charts will download and their progress displayed in the status window. Once completed you can exit the X-Traversal application and launch GPSNavX or MacENC. Refer to the GPSNavX and MacENC help specific to using charts. Note: The certificates.plist file must remain in the same folder as the downloaded charts.
